Compensation: Between \$23-27 per hour, commensurate with education and experience. Teaching hours are paid hourly.

Qualifications: A minimum of a Bachelor's degree in music (string pedagogy, performance, music education with string emphasis) is required. Teaching experience of at least two years at the beginner-early intermediate level is preferred but not required. Our ideal candidate would be energetic, able to communicate clearly with parents, knowledgeable in multiple approaches to teaching, creative, organized and a team-player.
